The Sunshine Rock Painting Club has a desire to spray (seal) painted rocks. Obviously, Retzlaff Hall, where the Rock Club meets, is not an appropriate place to spray sealant.

Colin Amos, my husband, spoke with John Chajec, and both Colin and I spoke with Sam Davis. Both John Chajec and Sam Davis agreed it is not a problem for the Rock Painters to use the spot behind the Workshop to spray rocks. In fact, people using the workshop cannot paint inside the workshop, and thus used the same area for painting woodshop projects.

In preparation for sealing rocks, and setting up a table and cardboard box, in that area, we cleaned the area, sweeping up glass, moving wood to a central space there, and bought a table, brought a box, and secured the box to the table to spray rocks. Paint sprayers can also use the same area to paint their projects. I understand no one has painted there recently.

I don't anticipate a conflict of time using the area, however, if a problem arises, the Rock Painting Club and, the Woodshop, will work out a schedule for use of the area. Only 1 person will use the area at a time. Rock painters will generally need just a few minutes, at a time, to spray their rocks. Whoever uses the area will be responsible to return area as it was, each time they use it.

If there's a prolonged use the the Woodshop, or by the Rock Painting Club, we can address schedules at that time.

If a Hurricane is predicted to hit our area, we, my husband and I, will remove the table and box to our home. I will get an alternate from the Rock Painting Club, in case we are unavailable. Names will be posted.
