Lights On -- Lock Up and Look Out for each other!

How to Safeguard Your Home Against Crime and Burglary etc. c/o Sgt. Michael Brooks, District representative – Harlingen Police Department

Walk around your home and scout out any weaknesses Keep shrubbery around entrances and walkways trimmed Build a fence if necessary Stow expensive items like grills, bicycles, etc. in the garage or secure shed Use curtains on garage windows Install motion detectors around your house – especially entrances Keep your yard free from debris (toys, tools, ladders, trash) Prune trees around houses Form a Neighborhood Watch Work with neighbors to clean up neighborhood if necessary Keep fences, gates and garage doors closed and locked Install large reflective numbers on your mailbox Keep all doors and windows locked at all times Secure valuables in a home safe or lock box Don't label your personal keys or hide spares outside Add privacy film to decorative windows Consider a home security system

Protect Your Home While On Vacation

Double and triple check all doors and windows before leaving Talk to neighbors about creating a "lived in look"
Put timers on lights
Lock your garage door and disconnect the automatic door opener Leave a radio on and lower the doorbell volume
Do not advertise your trip
