1. Block Captains: - We have 9 streets – Depending on the number of homes per street determines the number of a Block Captain and Co-Captains who play a role in keeping an eye out and sharing information. How 'bout signing up? This can be a yearly assignment or a *Winter Texan* commitment.

2. CERT Team:

We update our Sunshine Readiness Plan each April for PD, FD, EMT and Comm Center. You do not have to be a CERT member to assist. In March, we generally prepare some hints on how to get your home ready when heading "up North". But April is reserved for Disaster Preparedness.

3. Vendor Program
